Let's Cut the Nonsense

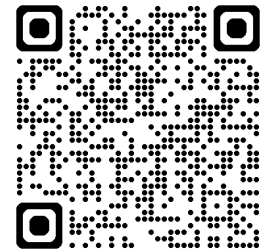
